## Danville wins regional the hard way

### Carroll, Warriors capture title with wins over Brebeuf, Mount Vernon (Fortville) by five combined points at Shelbyville

Things are good when a team is so tough that they rarely have a game that reflects their general descriptor.

In three sectional games, Danville's opponents rarely got within striking distance after the opening minutes, as the Warriors collected of 14, 34 and 16 points to coast to a championship.

Purdue-bound Travis Carroll has a lot to do with that, as the senior has dominated the glass and the scorebooks during the school's 23 victories before their Saturday sectional. But perhaps there was a hint for the star early in the season that things might be a little tougher when they arrived in Shelbyville for regionals.

Contained within a collection of blowouts was a narrow four-point victory at Brebeuf on February 6th, one in which the Braves players acknowledged earlier this week that they didn't play their best game during that contest.

It showed on Saturday, but again Danville's best was good enough. The Warriors survived the upset scare, sneaking by Brebeuf 47-46 on Saturday morning and then doing it again at night, beating Mount Vernon (Fortville) scoring a 47-43 victory for a regional championship.

Head coach Brian Barber collects his second regional championship at the school, having won his last during the 1999-2000 season, and improving the Warriors record to 25-1 on the season.
