

## Weidner Tagged MCC Men's Basketball Player of the Week

MARION, Ind. -- Being a freshman and coming off the Indiana Wesleyan University bench has yet to slow Jordan Weidner.

On Monday, Weidner was recognized for his high work rate as he was named Mid-Central College Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week. The honor is the first in his career.

Despite coming off the Indiana Wesleyan bench all season, Weidner has excelled and seen his playing time increase. Last week, Weidner averaged nearly 32 minutes of action in road wins at Goshen (Ind.) College and Bethel (Ind.) College.

Weidner scored a career-high 28 points at Goshen on 8-of-12 shooting and a perfect 10-of-10 from the foul line. He pulled down six rebounds and had three steals as Indiana Wesleyan escaped in an exciting 79-77 victory.

The guard finished his fine week with 14 points as IWU defeated Bethel, a team receiving votes in the NAIA poll. Even with just four shot attempts on Saturday, Weidner delivered at the foul line again with a 9-of-12 performance as Indiana Wesleyan won a 92-86 shootout.

Overall on the week, Weidner finished with 21.0 point and 5.0 rebounds as No. 19 Indiana Wesleyan improved to 10-3 and 3-0 in the MCC. Weidner shot 62.5-percent (10 of 16) from the floor and 86.4-percent (19 of 22) from the charity stripe.
